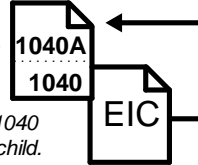

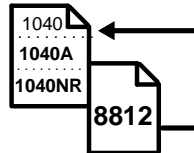

To take the making work pay credit, you must include your social security number (if filing a joint return, the number of either you or your spouse) on your tax return. A social security number does not include an identification number issued by the IRS. Only the Social Security Administration issues social security numbers.

You cannot take the making work pay credit if you can be claimed as someone else's dependent or if you are a nonresident alien.

Important: Check the "No" box on line 1a and see the instructions if:

- (a) You have a net loss from a business,
- (b) You received a taxable scholarship or fellowship grant not reported on a Form W-2,
- (c) Your wages include pay for work performed while an inmate in a penal institution,
- (d) You received a pension or annuity from a nonqualified deferred compensation plan or a nongovernmental section 457 plan, or
- (e) You are filing Form 2555 or 2555-EZ.
